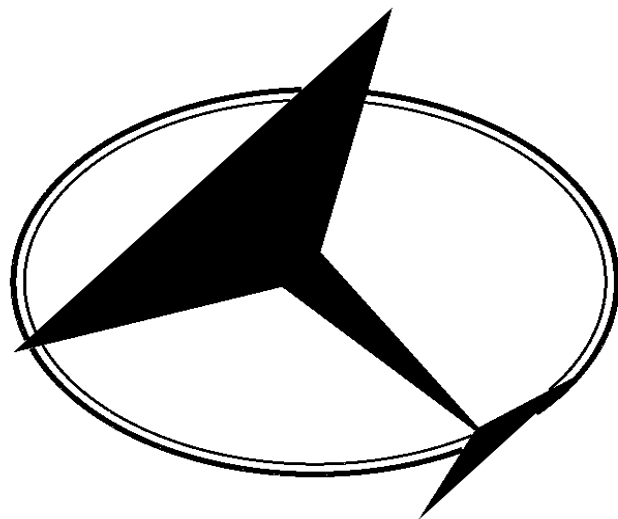

Navigation

Using I-71 (from North or South) or I-480 from the East

1. From the North or South, take I-71 to I-480W.
2. Take I-480W to the first exit, Airport / Grayton Road. (Exit 9)
3. Turn right (south) off the ramp towards the Airport.
4. Turn right (west) on Brookpark Road.
5. Take Brookpark across the bridge and turn right (north) onto West 220th St. (approx. 1.2 miles)
6. Take West 220th St. north for approx. 1.4 miles to Lorain Rd.
7. Turn right (east) onto Lorain Rd.
8. Take Lorain Rd. about 2/10ths of a mile to the traffic light at West 217th St.
9. Turn Left (north) onto West 217th St.
10. Proceed past the stop sign (Clifford Drive). The house is on the left about 10 houses down. Use the side door.

Using I-480 from the West

1. Take I-480W to the Airport exit. (Exit 9)
2. Turn right (west) off the ramp onto Brookpark Rd.
3. Follow steps 5 thru 10 above.

Using I-90 from the East

1. From the East, take I-90W to Hilliard Blvd.
2. Proceed straight (west) off the ramp onto Hilliard Blvd.
3. Proceed for approx. 0.7 miles to Wagar Rd.
4. Turn left (south) on Wagar Rd.
5. Proceed south on Wagar Rd. At the next light (Center Ridge Rd.), Wagar becomes West 210th St. Do not be alarmed.
6. Proceed south on West 210th St. to Westwood Road (about 0.9 miles from Center Ridge Road)
7. Turn right (west) onto Westwood Rd.
8. Proceed approx. 0.4 miles to West 217th Street. There is a green column on the north side of Westwood Rd. that is directly opposite West 217th St.
9. Turn left (south) onto West 217th St.
10. The house is on the right about halfway to the stop sign.

Using I-90 from the West

1. From the West, take I-90E to Detroit Road.
2. Get into the right lane on the ramp, but be aware that you will be turning LEFT.
3. Turn left (east) off the ramp onto Detroit Rd.
4. Just across the bridge, turn right onto Westway Drive.
5. At the first light, turn right (south) onto Wagar Road. It will become West 210th St. when you cross Center Ridge Road, but that's OK. Don't Panic!
6. Proceed for approx. 1.5 miles to Westwood Road.
7. Turn right (west) onto Westwood Rd.
8. Proceed approx. 0.4 miles to West 217th Street. There is a green column on the north side of Westwood Rd. that is directly opposite West 217th St.
9. Turn left (south) onto West 217th St.
10. The house is on the right about halfway to the stop sign.
